The Rail (formerly The Brass Rail) in Hillcrest has unveiled a new menu. Highlights include the Rail mac, a steaming bowl of elbow macaroni, prosciutto and grilled chicken in a creamy fontina (semisoft cow's cheese) and Gouda cheese sauce; Hillcrest po' boy, made with fresh romaine, sliced tomato, thick slices of avocado, grilled shrimp and a drizzling of a house-made remoulade (an aioli or mayonnaise-based condiment) sauce on a toasted French roll served with a side of marinated and pickled grilled vegetables; and crispy baked house wings tossed in a house-made buffalo sauce with a touch of smoky spice. 3796 Fifth Ave., San Diego.
