Before you try anything else, ORDER THE TOMATO FENNEL BISQUE. I kid you not, it's the best I have ever had. Ever.



It's a creamy, delicious blend of tomato, fennel, cream, and garlic – and for a small upcharge, you can have them add in a splash of exclusive Old Grove gin. (Do it.) The juniper berries in the gin mix delightfully with the fennel, and the garlic crostinis soak it all up.



I'm salivating just thinking about it!

Of course, as breakfast-holics, my sister and I went for some classic dishes with a trendy, gourmet twist:



**Breakfast Flatbread** {eggs + bacon + sausage + cheese + avocado + onion on focaccia}

**Waffle Sandwich** {scrambled eggs + bacon + avocado aioli + bacon jam between two Belgian waffles}



Both of these were absolutely delicious, with every mouthful bursting with flavor.
