
### STAY

The cozy rooms at the Hillcrest House Bed and Breakfast are perfect for a romantic weekend, while the Porto Vista Hotel has a stunning rooftop patio with harbor views that hosts an LGBT happy hour every Friday. The historic Lafayette Hotel in North Park exudes old Hollywood glam. Take in some fun in the sun at its epic summer pool parties. The pet-friendly Handlery Hotel San Diego has a sparkling pool and 10,000-square-foot secret garden. Looking for something a little more beachy? Try coastal boutique hotel Inn by the Sea at La Jolla or the oceanfront Inn at Sunset Cliffs.

### **PLAY**

Check out Martinis Above Fourth for one of their namesake cocktails and a cabaret show, or revel in the beach party vibe at Fiesta Cantina in Hillcrest. Pick up a pint at Hillcrest Brewing Company, the world's first openly gay brewery. Put on a show at low-key Redwing Bar & Grill in North Park: There's karaoke every night. Want to dance the night away? Check out The Rail, Rich's or women's bar Gossip Grill, or take the shuttle to Viejas Casino & Resort for a day of gambling, spa treatments and fine dining.





### EAT

At Trust in Hillcrest, woodfired meats and locally sourced ingredients take center stage. If you're looking for healthy Mexican fare and a fun atmosphere, Casa de Bandini in Carlsbad has you covered. Francophiles flock to The French Gourmet and Au Revoir French Bistro for indulgent culinary treats. Prepkitchen Little Italy serves up seasonal farm-to-table comfort food in a contemporary setting, while Florent downtown features foodie favorites from Top Chef alum Richard Sweeney. At the Firefly Restaurant & Bar at The Dana on Mission Bay, you'll dine on tapas and classic California fare against a beautiful bayfront backdrop.
